







5. Cooperation mechanisms

82%	DO NOT share volunteers with other bodies
79%	DO NOT manage or implement volunteer initiatives on behalf of others
76%	DO NOT externally monitor volunteer management/training
56%	DO NOT participate in or share volunteer training with other bodies
53%	DO NOT collaborate with other bodies in implementing criminal justice volunteer initiatives
53%	collaborate with other bodies in implementing volunteer initiatives generally
62%	is a member of a volunteer network or collaborative body

Recommendations

- **1.** Volunteer Recruitment & Selection: Improve the matching of volunteers' skills and interests with suitable roles. Enhance the use of communication channels to effectively reach out to potential volunteers.
- 2. Volunteer Training: Provide relevant training courses for personal and professional growth.
- **3. Volunteer Management & Leadership:** Enhance the visibility of volunteer commitment. Invest in training courses for staff and board members. Develop strategies to manage relationships with partner agencies.
- 4. Volunteer Support and Recognition: Develop and structure a formal recognition program to acknowledge volunteers' contributions.
- Cooperation mechanisms: Encourage CBOs to implement initiatives on behalf of other entities. Establish a volunteer network to optimize resources. Ensure external monitoring for adherence to best practices.
